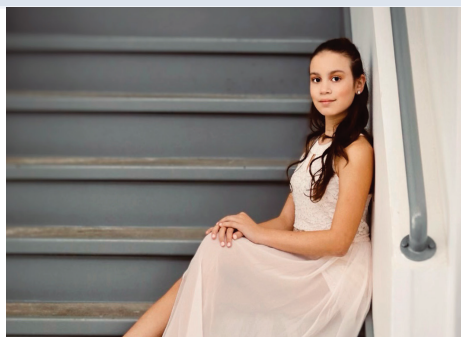
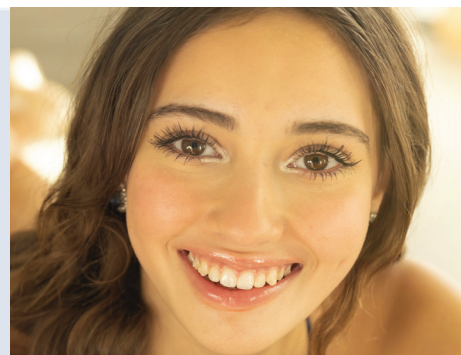

To mail a box to non-members who live out of town or deliver a bag to a local friend, there is a charge of \$30 for each.

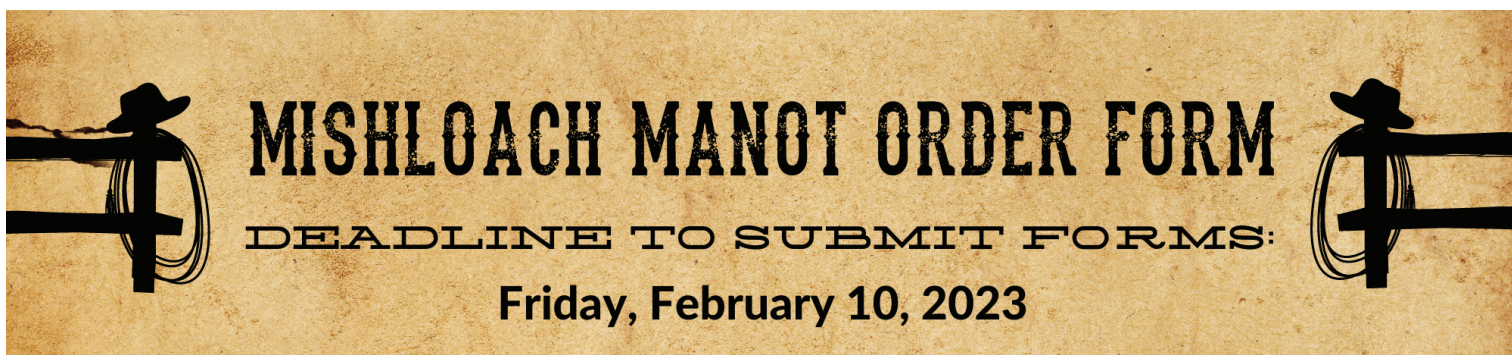

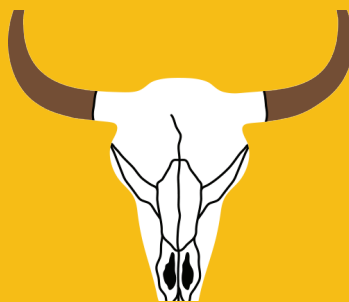

The Haggadah often feels opaque or confusing, an obstacle rather than an asset. But this is because we are looking for the wrong things. Together, we will reassess how the crafters of this text actually understood the mitzvah of “You shall

tell your children”, and use that framework to see how individual passages fit together to chart out a compelling and powerful emotional journey.

The mini-course will consist of three topics:

1. The Missing Story of the Haggadah
2. A Road Map through Maggid: Fitting the dots into a picture
3. The Art of Crafting a Book of Liturgy, or Why is finding “the right Haggadah” so hard?

Rabbi Joshua Cahan is a writer and educator in New York City. He compiled and edited the Yedid

Nefesh bencher and his new Pesach Haggadah is coming out this Spring. He currently lectures about liturgy and teaches at PRS, an online rabbinical program.

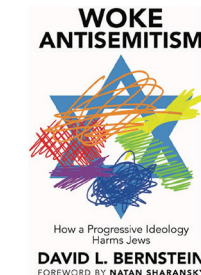
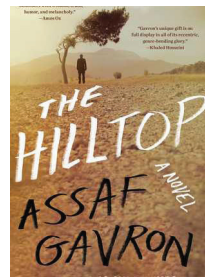

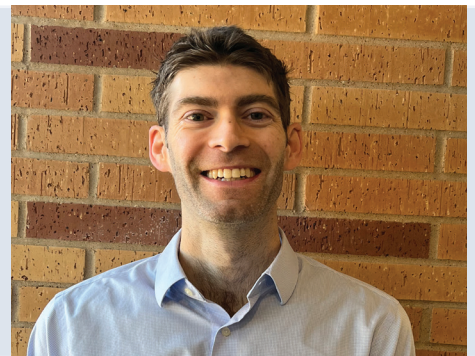

The food collection was a joint effort with the DBA and the DBA generously donated gift cards to each family.

Multi-generational congregants came together to help including Ann Cobert, her son Michael, and grandson Brett; Dr. Ellen and Mark Grishman and their children Avi & Rachel; and Kimberly Ross & her son, Shane, along with several friends from the 20's and 30's group. 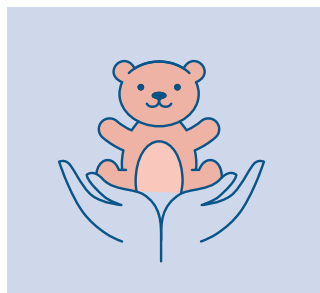

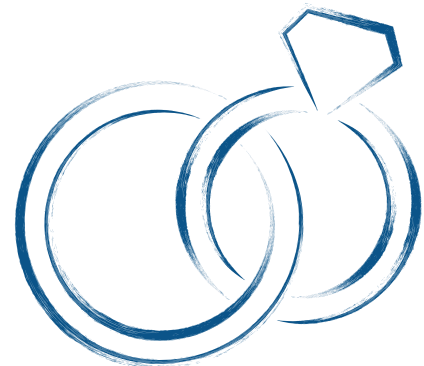

SAFETY AND SECURITY



With the growing scourge of antisemitism across the United States, now is an important time for Shearith to review our current safety and security procedures while exploring ways to improve measures moving forward. To that end, we have recently constituted a new Safety & Security Advisory Committee made up of a diverse group of congregants with relevant backgrounds, experience, and expertise. Our new committee recently had a fruitful kickoff meeting and identified some short-term steps to take that we hope are efficient and effective. We're seeking to move things forward on a variety of fronts.

One example is that we're reviewing the Security Assessment Report that the Community Security Initiative of the Jewish Federation of Greater Dallas conducted for our shul in December 2021. We're noting progress made and opportunities that still exist that can help us improve critical physical and procedural vulnerabilities. Another example is reassessing how and when we employ security officers with respect to open doors,

the flow of foot traffic, and the size of groups and meetings on onsite.

In addition, we're looking to acquire and strategically place Stop the Bleed kits on the property coupled with providing the appropriate training necessary for using these life-saving measures successfully! Two other examples include: 1) Enhancing the signage indicating the location of the two defibrillators we have on campus; and 2) Returning to using a daily sign-in log at the main receptionist desk for all people who come onsite during normal business hours, Monday through Friday. **We'll be asking anyone seeking access to the property – including visitors and members – to sign in and out when they are here.** This simple measure not only is a basic step on the front end to identify every person on the premises; it also provides us a record of who is onsite at any given time which is critical information to know in the event of an emergency incident.

While we can obviously never guarantee everyone's safety and security at any given time, it is within our power to work together in an informed and intentional way to take reasonable measures to shore up any critical physical and procedural weaknesses we may have. GETTING YOUR HOME READY FOR PESACH

On Pesach, the most complex Jewish holiday, The Bible prohibits the eating of leaven during the festival of Pesach (Exodus 12:15-20). The Hebrew word *chametz* is translated as leavened bread and refers to food prepared from five species of grain – wheat, barley, oats, spelt and rye. *Matzah*, unleavened bread, can be made from any of these five grain species, but It is customary to make *matzah* only from wheat flour. It is essential that the wheat and flour not be given the chance to leaven, so the grain must be kept perfectly dry. The rule against leaven applies to eating, enjoying any benefit or possessing leavened bread. Before the arrival of Pesach, all leaven should be removed from your home and possession. If you've never done these rituals before, try choosing one this year -- a thorough cleaning; searching for *chametz*; or burning *chametz*.

Before Tuesday night, April 4, the entire house can be cleaned and checked for *chametz*, including all counters and cupboards, dishes changed out, and surfaces covered. For complete details on how to clean and *kasher* your kitchen, and a kosher-for-Pesach product guide, go to Shearith.org

Tuesday Night, April 4, after dark:

Bedikat Chametz (Searching for Chametz)

On Thursday evening, after cleaning is finished, we inspect our house one last time for *chametz*. We begin this search with the following *bracha* (blessing):

Pre-Search for Chametz Blessing

ברוך אתה ה' אלקינו מלך העולם, אשר קדשנו במצוותיו, וצונו
בעור חמץ

*Baruch atah Adonai Eloheinu melech ha-olam, asher kid'shanu
b'mitzvotav, v'tzivanu al bi-ur chametz.*

Blessed are You, Adonai our God, King of the Universe, who has sanctified us with His commandments, and commanded us concerning the destruction of *chametz*.

In this wonderful family ritual, you can “hide” ten pieces of *chametz*, like Cheerios or pasta. Search high and low! Grab a candle, a wooden spoon, and a feather. Holding the candle, search for the *chametz* and scoop it onto the spoon with the feather, then put it in a paper bag to destroy Wednesday morning. Take the bag and make the following declaration stating that house is free of *chametz*!

All *chametz* that is in my possession which I have not recognized or seen, and has not been removed, and that I do

not know about, should hereby be annulled and ownerless, like the dust of the earth.

Wednesday morning, April 5: *Siyum Habechorim* (Fast of the First-born) in the Topletz Auditorium and via ZOOM at 8 am. The first-born male of a family is obligated to fast on Erev Pesach (the day of the first Seder). This fast can be avoided by attending a special Torah class called a *siyum*, celebrating the completion of a body of Torah learning. Go to www.shearith.org/pesach

Wednesday Morning, April 5:

Biyur Chametz (Destroying Chametz)

On Wednesday, by 12:25 pm, we destroy all of the *chametz* in our homes by burning it. After, we make a declaration that we have destroyed all of the *chametz*.

Any *chametz* that is in my possession, whether I have recognized it, seen it, or removed it or not, should hereby be annulled and ownerless like the dust of the earth.

Wednesday evening, April 5, and Thursday evening, April 6: Candle-lighting

Before you light holiday candles on Wednesday evening, you can light a Yahrzeit candle or other long-burning candle. While we do not strike matches on Yom Tov, we may transfer fire from an existing flame. So, you can light your Thursday evening and Friday evening candles from that long-burning candle.

After lighting your holiday candles say the following two blessings:
