Netanel Goldberg, vocal artist, prayer leader, guitarist, composer, creator, and writer, is an Israeli singer-songwriter, who inspired our Prayer Rhythms service. Netanel, from a family of cantors and prayer leaders, first sang at the bimah at eight-years-old. More

recently, Netanel began to develop spaces for alternative prayer, healing through song and chanting of the heart. Today he leads prayers and healing circles in Israel, Europe, and the United States.

Nimrod Nol, an international violinist, has appeared throughout the world with a wide variety of musical artists including Kelly Clarkson, Omar Faruk, Tekbilek Ebi and The Moshav Band. Nimrod released his first solo album last May.

From the USCJ:

"Increasingly, people are now able to experience an authentic and dynamic Judaism not only in person at their local synagogue, but also virtually from their cell phones, computers and tablets thanks to livestreaming. There are professionals who stream when they are traveling out of town for work. There are couples that stream from their cruise ship or hotel when they are away on vacation. There are people who are recovering from surgeries or battling illnesses, or seniors who find it too difficult to come to synagogue to attend in person each week. "They might not be able to make it, but they can always stream."
