The sandwich drive was such a simple thing; but what impressed me was the amount of planning behind it. One reason I am happy I have been involved with Social Action at Shearith is the chance I've had to know Larry Krasner better. Larry and his family regularly take snacks and water to the police and firefighters in their neighborhood. Larry and his wife host a very successful MS fundraiser every year. And Larry's been stalwart on the Social Action committee, volunteering at every opportunity. So, he does plenty already. But he really wanted to have a sandwich drive.



To tell the truth. I did not understand his focus on this one mitzvah.

But, on the day, seeing all the families trudging in with their boxes and bags of sandwiches, I realized it was the ultimate simple act of kindness--to make a meal for someone that you don't know. The simplicity was deceptive. A lot of careful planning and discussion was needed to connect with Austin Street, and to time the delivery and rent and drive the truck. Fortunately, the shul has a Larry, and a Carol Pinker, who are willing to persist with all these details. And the children already assume there will be another sandwich drive. I heard a boy talking about it that day!

Consecration By Sarah Lipinsky, Director of Education

Consecration is a ceremony of blessing and dedication to God. We celebrate Consecration in 3rd grade rather than kindergarten, because of the significant difference in the maturity of a child's soul. Third grade marks when our talmidim (students) and their families make a stronger commitment to Jewish learning. School is in session more days and more hours. The time they spend in class is still fun, but there are moments of serious study and concentration and in-depth soul searching as a Jewish person. Our talmidim learn to ask guestions and find more meaning.

At Consecration, we learned about Havdalah and the talmidim led our congregation in reciting the four blessings. Each student spoke on what being Jewish means to them. Then one family member shared a meaningful Shabbat memory from when they were in 3rd grade. Rabbi Sunshine presented each student with a siddur, donated by SISterhood, then he taught the families an interactive version of the Shema with a new and joyful tune.

The 3rd graders and their siblings handpicked spices to create their own spice jars. I am so proud of Kitah Gimel's (3rd grade) commitment to Jewish learning!

Over the past decade, the Middle East has transformed dramatically: centers of power have changed, threats of jihadism and of Iranian ambitions in the region have created new alliances between Israel and Arab states. And the United States has changed its posture in the Middle East, with persistent and growing preferences for a policy of retrenchment. What are the resulting risks and opportunities for Israel, within its borders, in the region and in the world?



Dr. Natan Sachs is the Director of the Brookings Institution's Center for Middle East Policy in Washington D.C. His research focuses on Israel, in particular its foreign policy, domestic politics, and U.S.-Israeli relations. A native of Jerusalem, Sachs holds a bachelor's degree from the Amirim Honors Program at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, and an M.A. and Ph.D. in political science from Stanford University.

Judge Barbara Lynn

Shearith Israel SISterhood is pleased to welcome Judge Barbara Lynn as the quest speaker at the annual Women of Note luncheon. Judge Lynn is a native of Binghamton, New York, who received her undergraduate degree from the University of Virginia and a law degree at Southern Methodist University. She became the first female associate at Carrington Coleman in Dallas and later the firm's first female partner. In 1999 she was nominated by President Bill Clinton to a seat on the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas vacated by Harry Barefoot Sanders, Jr. On May 1, 2016 she became the Chief Judge of the Northern District of Texas, the first woman to hold the position.



Getting Your Home Ready for Pesach...

Pesach (Passover) is the most complex Jewish holiday, filled with seeming minutia of Jewish law. Below is a step-by-step guide to preparing for Pesach. This can seem like an overwhelming amount of work. If you have never done any of these rituals, try choosing one this year. Try doing a thorough cleaning. Or, try just doing the search for chametz. Or, just burn your chametz this year. Trying something new makes a familiar holiday fresh each year!

Until Sunday night, March 29: Cleaning!!!

On Pesach we are commanded to refrain from eating chametz (anything leavened), and we are also prohibited from benefiting from it, or even seeing it! So, before Tuesday night, the entire house should be cleaned and checked for chametz. All counters and cupboards should be cleaned out, dishes changed, and surfaces covered as necessary. Our website, www.shearith.org, has complete details on how to clean and kasher every piece of your kitchen, as well as a guide to kosherfor-Pesach products.

Thursday Night, March 29, after dark: Bedikat Chametz (Searching for Chametz)

On Tuesday evening, after all the cleaning is finished, we inspect our house one last time for chametz. We begin this search with the following bracha (blessing):

Pre-Search for Chametz Blessing

בָּרוּך אַתָּה ה' אֱלקִינו מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, אֲשֶׁר קִדְשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתִיו וְצַנָּנוּ עֵל בִּעוּר חָמֵץ

Baruch atah Adonai Eloheinu melech ha-olam, asher kid'shanu b'mitzvotav, v'tzivanu al bi-ur chameitz.

Blessed are You, Adonai our God, King of the Universe, who has sanctified us with His commandments, and commanded us concerning the destruction of chametz.

We search high and low with a candle, a wooden spoon and a feather for this final round of "hide and seek." This is a wonderful family ritual: 'Hide' ten final bread pieces (or Cheerios, pasta, or other chametz) around the house. Holding the candle, search for the chametz and scoop it onto the spoon with the feather. Put it all together in a paper bag to destroy on Wednesday morning. After the chametz is gathered, we make the following declaration stating that our house is free of chametz.

All chametz that is in my possession which I have not recognized or seen, and has not been removed, and that I do not know about, should hereby be annulled and ownerless like the dust of the earth.

Friday morning, March 30: Siyum Habechorim (Fast of the First-born) Minvan 7 am

The first-born male of a family is obligated to fast on Erev Pesach (the day of the first Seder). This fast can be avoided by attending a special Torah class called a siyum, celebrating the completion of a body of Torah learning. Every year, our Thursday morning Dive into Talmud class celebrates their learning at this siyum.

Friday Morning, March 30: Biyur Chametz (Destroying Chametz) On Monday morning, by 12:28 pm, we destroy all of the chametz in our homes by burning it. After we burn our chametz, we make the following declaration starting that we have destroyed all of the chametz.

Any chametz that is in my possession, whether I have recognized it, seen it, or removed it or not, should hereby be annulled and ownerless like the dust of the earth.

Friday evening, March 30, and Saturday evening, March 31: Candle-lighting

Before you light your holiday candles on Friday evening, you can light a Yahrzeit candle or other long-burning candle. While we do not strike matches on Yom Tov, we may transfer fire from an existing flame. So, you can light your Tuesday evening candles from that long-burning candle.

After lighting your holiday candles on Friday and Saturday say the following two blessings:

Blessed are You, Adonai our God, King of the Universe, granting us life, sustaining us, and enabling us to reach this day.

The Bible prohibits the eating of leaven during the festival of Pesach (Exodus 12:15-20). The Hebrew word "chametz" is translated as leavened bread and refers to food prepared from five species of grain – wheat, barley, oats, spelt and rye – that has been allowed to leaven. Matzah (unleavened bread) is made from any of these aforementioned five species of grain. It is customary, however, to make matzah from wheat flour only, and it is essential that the wheat and flour be given no chance to leaven. Hence, the grain used for matzah must be kept perfectly dry.

The rule against leaven applies not only to its consumption but also to enjoying any benefit thereof and even to its possession. Therefore, before the arrival of Pesach, all leaven must be removed from one's premises and legal possession.
